 RE: Key Findings from Surveys on New "BBB" Plan
 DATE: August 8, 2022

Live interviewer telephone surveys of likely voters were conducted on behalf of the American Action Network in three congressional districts across the country. Cygnal conducted the survey in NY-17 from July 31 to August 2, 2022. Tarrance Group conducted the survey in MI-07 from August 1-4, 2022. Public Opinion Strategies conducted the survey in TX-28 from August 1-4, 2022. All three surveys were conducted with n=400 likely voters using a mix of cell phone and landline interviews and have a margin of error of ±4.9 percentage points.

KEY FINDINGS

Key Provisions in the "Build Back Better" plan are toxic and House Members who vote for the plan will have to defend wildly unpopular policies. Raising taxes in the middle of a recession, giving \$7,500 tax breaks for wealthy families to buy luxury electric cars, and doubling the size of the IRS all make respondents over 50% less likely to vote for a candidate that supported them. Notably, the intensity behind the opposition is significant, with several registering over 50% "much less likely." Tax credits for luxury electric vehicles were the most toxic of the proposals, hitting as high as 61% less likely and 52% much less likely.
