# Methodology

- AAN commissioned American Viewpoint and Meeting Street to conduct a survey among likely voters in Battleground and Safe GOP congressional districts to understand attitudes and opinions on the current political environments and several policy proposals.
- Respondents came from a national online panel and were matched to the Data Trust voter file.
- The surveys were conducted in the Safe GOP districts from July 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and in the Battleground districts from July 8<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- The margin of error for the battleground sample (n=1073) is +/- 3.0% at the 95% confidence level. The margin of error for the Safe GOP sample (n=1200) is +/- 2.8% at the 95% confidence level. The margin of error among sub-groups is greater.
- In addition, voters with recent GOP primary vote history are also broken out across both district types. The margin of error for the GOP Primary sample (n=713) is +/-3.7% at the 95% confidence level.

# *Agenda is Focused on Top Issues*

# ECONOMIC/POCKETBOOK ISSUES

There is widespread support for the agenda’s economic and pocketbook policies, including using tax incentives to bring manufacturing jobs back from China, stopping the Biden Administration’s policies of paying people not to work, ending misaligned and wasteful spending, and rolling back Biden’s restrictions on American energy production.

The following are several issues that a Republican candidate for Congress could address. Please indicate if each would make you more or less likely to vote for a Republican candidate for Congress, or if it wouldn’t make a difference.

# INFLATION ISSUES

In both safely Republican districts and battleground districts, there is wide agreement that Democrats have no plan to fix inflation, and to a slightly lesser degree, that their reckless spending policies are a major reason for record high inflation.

# PUBLIC SAFETY ISSUES

This agenda's policy of combatting illegal immigration by verifying status when applying for a job and stopping the welfare incentives that can attract illegal crossings garner widespread agreement among voters. Agenda items focused on hiring bonuses for officers and stopping funding of prosecutors who won't prosecute crimes are also widely supported.

The following are several issues that a Republican candidate for Congress could address. Please indicate if each would make you more or less likely to vote for a Republican candidate for Congress, or if it wouldn't make a difference.

[HALF SAMPLE] Funding <u>hiring bonuses to recruit more police officers</u> and address the police shortage across the country.	+37%	+24%	30%	21%
[HALF SAMPLE] Placing a <u>hold on federal funds for local prosecutors and district attorneys who refuse to prosecute crimes</u> and requiring prosecutors to disclose what crimes are not being prosecuted in order to receive federal funds.	+40%	+21%	38%	29%

# IMMIGRATION/CRIME ISSUES

Large majorities of voters in both safely GOP and battleground districts agree that the border must be secured and the humanitarian crisis happening there be addressed quickly. There is also widespread agreement that Democrats' support for defunding the police is driving the rise in crime seen around the country.

# EDUCATION ISSUES

Voters support the agenda’s policies of protecting girls’ school sports and passing a Parents’ Bill of Rights to ensure transparency.

<b>[HALF SAMPLE]</b> <u>Banning transgender girls from competing in girls’ school sports.</u>	+41%	+24%	41%	30%
Passing a <u>Parents’ Bill of Rights</u> that would increase transparency to ensure parents know what their children are being taught in schools and how their tax dollars are being spent. This will also ensure parents’ voices will be heard by administrators and school boards.	+39%	+14%	38%	28%

# Conclusions & Recommendations

1. This survey data shows that American voters widely support the policies included in the recently unveiled Commitment to America.
2. This agenda addresses the top concerns of voters who think the country is off on the wrong track by focusing on a plan to fight inflation and reduce gas prices. Simply, most voters rightly see President Biden, Speaker Pelosi and Congressional liberals as having no plan to fix inflation. Instead of Democrats' socialist spending schemes driving up inflation, American voters favor this agenda's substantive proposals that will move supply chains back from China, roll back Biden energy restrictions to lower energy costs, and stop reckless spending. American voters agree that these policies will help address inflation and improve the economy.
3. There is also widespread support for this agenda's public safety policies, both in terms of border security and crime, and this contrasts with liberals' failed policies of defunding the police and encouraging a wide-open border. This agenda's policy of combatting illegal immigration by verifying status when applying for a job and stopping the welfare incentives that can attract illegal crossings are widely agreed with by voters. Agenda items focused on hiring bonuses for officers and stopping funding of prosecutors who won't prosecute crimes are also widely supported.
4. Finally, the agenda's education platform garners support for policies that allow our children to succeed, give transparency to what is being taught in the classroom and ensure girls' sports are fair.
